The **reserve price** of the e-auction is **Rs. 18,62,000/-** inclusive GST.

1.1 Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- The bidder should have PAN Number.
- The bidder should have GST Number
- The Bidder should not have been blacklisted by any State/Central Government/ Public Sector Undertaking. The bidder should submit an affidavit in this regard.

1.2 Other Terms & Conditions

1. The electricity connection will be arranged by the party of its own along with safety certificate from Competent Authority.
2. No other stalls except Jhulla and joy rides will be allowed to the successful bidder.
3. Fitness Certificate from the appropriate authority i.e. GM, CTU or Engineering Department Chandigarh Administration of the complete equipments installed in the Amusement Park on daily basis shall be arranged by the successful bidder on its own.
4. The highest bidder will arrange insurance Cover Certificate in respect of each person riding the Amusement Games.
5. All Rules and Regulations of Chandigarh Administration meant for putting up Amusement Games at the above said event, shall be adhered in all respect by the highest bidder.
6. The highest bidder shall ensure that the norms of Chandigarh Administration regarding sound and smoke pollution to be adhered to while plying the equipments.
7. The highest bidder shall submit the Fitness Certificate well before the start of Chandigarh Carnival & as well as on daily basis to the undersigned otherwise you will not be allowed to operate the jhullas.

8. The successful bidder is required to deposit 25% amount of the total auctioned money immediately on the fall of the hammer and 75% amount with 10 days from the issue of the allotment of contract.
9. In case, the bidder backup after the acceptance of the allotment letter, the total loss to the Tourism Department/Chandigarh Carnival Society will fully be recovered from the bidder.
10. The area/space for the installation of the Amusement Park will be as per previous practice for which interested bidder may contact office and the area/space will be shown to them physically by the representative of Director Tourism-cum-Secretary, Chandigarh Carnival Society.
11. Any activity other than the said contract, if found carried out by the successful bidder, the entire contract shall be cancelled immediately and the total amount deposited with the Chandigarh Carnival Society shall be forfeited apart from suitable action as deemed fit shall be initiated.
12. The highest bidder shall ensure the complete cleanliness in and around the Amusement Park.
13. All the cost of tentage material will be borne by the firm.
14. The EMD of the successful bidder will be released after successful completion of the event.
15. The bidder shall not carry any unauthorized activity banned by the government/Chandigarh Administration.
16. The firm if found not abiding by the terms & conditions of the contract, the earnest money will be forfeited and the firm shall be black-listed.
17. In case of any dispute arisen between agency & the Chandigarh Carnival Society, the jurisdiction shall be Chandigarh.
18. The bidder shall be responsible for any untoward incident during the operating of Jhulla.

1.3 Submission of Proposal

The Bidders shall submit their Proposals/ Bids online in Electronic Format with Digital Signatures. For participation in the above e-tendering process, the Bidders shall have to get themselves registered with <https://etenders.chd.nic.in> and get User ID, Password. Digital Signature is mandatory to participate in the e-tendering process.

Earnest Money Deposit (as mentioned in the advertisement) shall have to be submitted physically in the office of Director Tourism-cum-Secretary Carnival in the shape of Demand Draft in favour of **Director Tourism Department, Chandigarh, payable at Chandigarh before 30th October 2018 by 04.00 p.m.**

Soft copy of the demand draft should be uploaded online while applying for the tender.

Scanned copies of all the documents i.e. technical and financial proposal shall be uploaded as part of the Proposal within the prescribed time limit.
