1.1 Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- The bidder should have valid PAN Number.
- The bidder should have valid GST Number.
- The Bidder should not have been blacklisted by any State/Central Government/ Public Sector Undertaking. The bidder should submit an affidavit in this regard.

1.2 Other Terms & Conditions

1. Area of putting the stalls space will be specified/allotted by the Committee constituted by Tourism Department. Allotment will be made to the agency/individual who gave the highest bid for in the e-bid. The interested parties want to see the space to be allotted for food stalls may visit office on any working day and a representative will show the space of food stalls.
2. The participation amount/EMD will be returned to the unsuccessful bidder.
3. There will also be large space with sitting area shall be allotted to government agencies like CITCO, CIHM and AIHM for setting of food arena during the festival for which the bidder shall not have any objection.
4. 25% amount of the highest bid should be deposited on the same day on the date of issue of order. The rest of the amount should be deposited on the next day from the date of issue of order in the shape of Demand Draft/NEFT/RTGS.
5. The Director Tourism, Chandigarh reserves the right to allot more than one stalls.
6. Maintenance of hygiene is responsibility of party.
7. No music is allowed in stall.
8. Fire safety in stall is responsibility of party.
9. The party shall be responsible for food and safety license.
10. The quality of the food shall be standardized.
11. Violation of terms & conditions will lead to cancellation and blacklisting.

1.3 Submission of Proposal

The Bidders shall submit their Proposals/ Bids online in Electronic Format with Digital Signatures. For participation in the above e-tendering process, the Bidders shall have to get themselves registered with <https://etenders.chd.nic.in> and get User ID, Password. Digital Signature is mandatory to participate in the e-tendering process.

Earnest Money Deposit (as mentioned in the advertisement) shall have to be submitted physically in the office of Director Tourism in the shape of Demand Draft in favour of Director Tourism Department, Chandigarh, payable at Chandigarh before opening of technical bid. In case of EMD is not submitted physically well before time, the bid will be rejected outrightly.

Scanned copies of all the documents i.e. technical and financial proposal shall be uploaded as part of the Proposal within the prescribed time limit.
