## Know the History

#### CHANDIGARH WAR MEMORIAL

The War Memorial, situated in Sector 3, spans over 20 acres of land, making it one of the largest post-independence war memorials in India. This solemn monument pays tribute to the memory of nearly 8,459 soldiers from the Navy, Army, and Air Force. Constructed with walls made of pink sandstone, it includes a terrace-like seating area that offers a contemplative space for reflection remembrance.









## **CHANDIGARH DESTINATION FEATURES**

#### How to reach:

Airport: It is well-connected to the rest of the country and has direct flights to Delhi, Mumbai, Jaipur, Bengaluru, Srinagar and other cities. Air India and indigo offer two international flights to Dubai.



Train: The Chandigarh railway station has good connections to the metros. It is connected to Delhi and other major cities. Vande Bharat and Shatabdi run from Chandigarh to other destinations.



Road: The inter-state bus terminals (ISBT) in sector 17 and in sector 43 have daily buses to the different state.



Where to stay: Taj, Hyatt, JW Marriott, Lalit, MountView are among the luxury stays. Mid Range and Budget options are also available.



Best time to visit Chandigarh: Between September to April and Monsoons.



Temperature: Peak summers see a high of 48°C while in winters the temperature dips to 2 - 3°C.


#### DID YOU KNOW?



The Open Hand Monument, conceived by architect Le Corbusier as a symbol of peace, stands at the heart of his vision. This 26-meter-high metal structure symbolizes openness, with a tagline representing this duality as "Open to give, Open to receive." Intriguingly, the hand structure functions as a weather vane, rotating in harmony with the wind's direction. Located within the Capitol Complex, the monument ascends prominently, while an acoustically designed amphitheater surrounds it, enhancing its significance as a symbol of harmony and interconnectedness.
