War Memorial

The **Chandigarh War Memorial** is a distinguished landmark, recognized as the largest post-Independence war memorial in India. It honors the sacrifices of nearly 8,459 soldiers from the Army, Air Force, and Navy who laid down their lives since 1947.

Inauguration: The memorial was inaugurated by the late Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam in 2006, adding historical significance to its establishment.

- **Pink Sandstone Walls:** The memorial's walls are crafted from pink sandstone, adding aesthetic beauty to the structure.

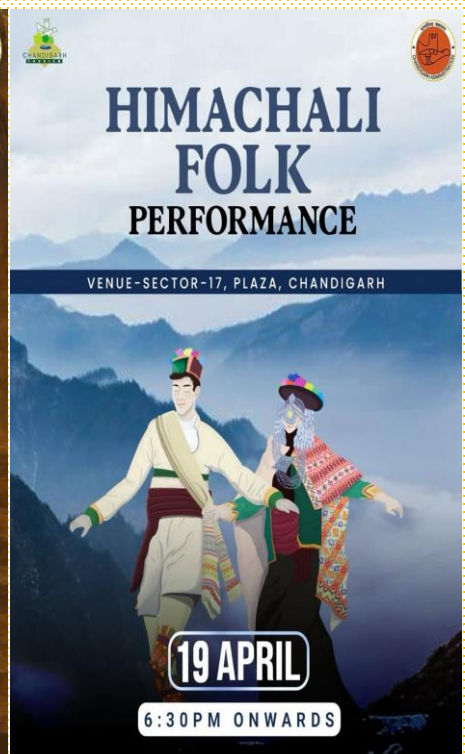
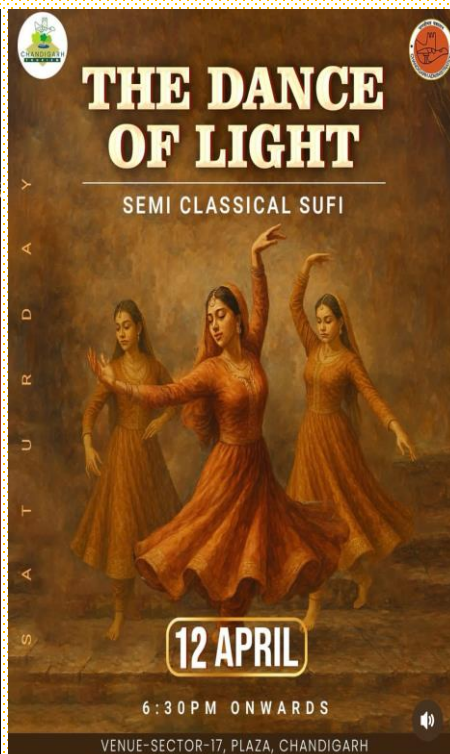
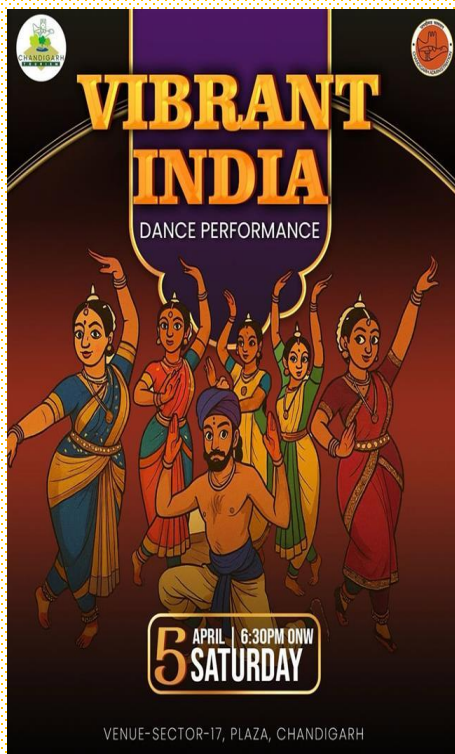

CHANDIGARH DESTINATION SNAPSHOT

How to reach



Airport: It is well-connected to the rest of the country and has direct flights to Delhi, Mumbai, Jaipur, Bengaluru, Srinagar and other cities. Air India and indigo offer two international flights to Dubai.



Train: The Chandigarh railway station has good connections to the metros. It is connected to Delhi and other major cities. Vande Bharat and Shatabdi run from Chandigarh to other destinations.



Road: The inter-state bus terminals (ISBT) in sector 17 and in sector 43 have daily buses to the different state.



Where to stay: Hotel Mount View, Hotel Shivalik View, Hotel Park View, and UT-Guest-2 House are government accommodations. Additionally, many five-star, three-star, and mid-range budget options are available.



Best time to visit Chandigarh: Between September to April and Monsoons.



Temperature: Peak summers see a high of 48°C while in winters the temperature dips to 2 - 3°C.
