Sukhna Lake, Chandigarh

Nestled at the foothills of the majestic Shivalik range, Sukhna Lake serves as a tranquil escape, offering picturesque views and vibrant birdlife that make it a must-visit destination in Chandigarh.


This 3-square-kilometer rainfed lake was created in 1958 by damming the Sukhna Choe, a seasonal stream descending from the Shivalik hills. Over the years, it has evolved into a sanctuary for exotic migratory birds especially during the winter months. This lake boasts the channel for rowing events, promising thrilling experiences on the water.

Sukhna Lake, Chandigarh

Major attractions are

- Boating Adventures: 2 types of peddle boats 2-seater and 4-seater.
- Portrait Making: Portrait artists make the sketches. Charges range from Rs. 200 to Rs. 500
- Amusement Park: Train rides, bull ride and other joy rides for children
- Eating point: CITCO Cafeteria, Chef Lakeview and other eating shops to munch on food.
- Garden of Silence: Meditative space at the end of Sukhna Lake. Features seated Buddha.
- Sukhna Interpretation Centre: Indian Art Museum to learn about environmental conservation and appreciate the artistic exhibits.
- Sukhna Wildlife Sanctuary: Reserved for the Conservation of flora and fauna. Information panels displays details about them.

Timings to visit the attraction: 5 AM. to 9 PM. (Monday-Sunday)

Entry Fee: Free






Sukhna Lake – Sector 1 of Chandigarh

Sector 10, Chandigarh and Rose garden, Sector 16, Chandigarh.


Date: February 21st to 23rd, 2025

Entry fee: Free for all visitors.






ROSE FESTIVAL BY CHANDIGARH TOURISM

The 53rd Rose Festival, organized by the Chandigarh Municipal Corporation, took place from February 21 to 23, 2025, at the Zakir Hussain Rose Garden in Sector 16, Chandigarh.

Event attractions:

Cultural Performances: The festival featured a variety of cultural performances, including folk dance competitions, bhangra by the Chandigarh Nirol Savachar Academy, and musical evenings with as Sukhi Brar and the Lopoke artists such Brothers.

Competitions and Activities: Visitors engaged competitions like the Rose Prince and Princess contest, kite flying shows, photography contests, Gatka performances, Rose King and Queen (Senior Citizen) contests, rose quizzes, Mr. and Miss Rose competitions, on-the-spot painting contests, and antakshari competitions.

Special Attractions: A unique feature of the festival was the "Zero Waste" initiative, which included the Swachh Game Zone dedicated to Indian games promoting cleanliness and hygiene. Additionally, stalls were set up to create awareness about recycled products, home composting, and products made from floral waste, reflecting the festival's commitment to sustainability community and empowerment.





CHANDIGARH DESTINATION SNAPSHOT

How to reach



Airport: It is well-connected to the rest of the country and has direct flights to Delhi, Mumbai, Jaipur, Bengaluru, Srinagar and other cities. Air India and indigo offer two international flights to Dubai.



Train: The Chandigarh railway station has good connections to the metros. It is connected to Delhi and other major cities. Vande Bharat and Shatabdi run from Chandigarh to other destinations.



Road: The inter-state bus terminals (ISBT) in sector 17 and in sector 43 have daily buses to the different state.



Where to stay: Hotel Mount View, Hotel Shivalik View, Hotel Park View, and UT-Guest-2 House are government accommodations. Additionally, many five-star, three-star, and mid-range budget options are available.



Best time to visit Chandigarh: Between September to April and Monsoons.



Temperature: Peak summers see a high 48°C while in winters temperature dips to 2 - 3°C.
