# **EXPERIENCE OF THE MONTH**

### THE INDIAN AIR FORCE HERITAGE CENTRE, CHANDIGARH

On June 3, 2022, the Chandigarh Administration and the Indian Air Force signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for the establishment of the Indian Air Force Heritage Centre in Chandigarh, situated in the Government Press Building in Sector 18, which was witnessed by Sh. Banwarilal Purohit, Governor of Punjab and Administrator of Chandigarh, Smt. Kirron Kher, Member of Parliament, Air Chief Marshal VR Chaudhari, Chief of the Air Staff, and Sh. Dharam Pal, Adviser to the Administrator. Subsequently, on May 08, 2023, Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh inaugurated the Centre, which housed a collection of artifacts, murals, 3D dioramas, decommissioned aircraft, aero engines, scale models, war stories, simulators, AR/VR experiences, a movie and holographic theater, and interactive boards.


























# **EXPERIENCE OF THE MONTH**

### THE INDIAN AIR FORCE HERITAGE CENTRE, CHANDIGARH

The Centre showcased the IAF's evolution, technological progress, and various facets of Air Force operations, highlighting the important role played by the IAF in humanitarian assistance, disaster relief, and combat capabilities, thereby helping to raise awareness about the role and contribution of the Indian Air Force in national security and defense, and attracting tourists, students, youth, and the general populace to serve as an educational and informative center, including a café and a souvenir shop.

In his address, Shri Rajnath Singh termed the Heritage Centre as a testament to the courage and dedication of those who had served in the IAF, highlighting their contributions in wars such as the 1948 conflict, the Goa Liberation War of 1961, and the wars of 1962, 1965, 1971, and Kargil. He emphasized that the 1971 war demonstrated unparalleled jointmanship, integration, and commitment by the three Services, fought for humanity and democracy rather than land or power, and expected the Centre to serve as a source of inspiration for future generations by preserving the IAF's history and motivating youth to embrace the values of the Armed Forces. Governor of Punjab & Administrator of Chandigarh Shri Banwarilal Purohit and Chief of the Air Staff Air Chief Marshal VR Chaudhari were among those present on the occasion.






### How to reach:

**Airport**: It is well-connected to the rest of the country and has direct flights to Delhi, Mumbai, Jaipur, Bengaluru, Srinagar and other cities. Air India and indigo offer two international flights to Dubai.



**Train**: The Chandigarh railway station has good connections to the metros. It is connected to Delhi and other major cities. Vande Bharat and Shatabdi run from Chandigarh to other destinations.



**Road**: The inter-state bus terminals (ISBT) in sector 17 and in sector 43 have daily buses to the different state.



Where to stay: Hotel Mount View, Hotel Shivalik View, Hotel Park View, and UT-Guest-2 House are government accommodations. Additionally, many five-star, three-star, and mid-range budget options are available.



**Best time to visit Chandigarh:** Between September to April and Monsoons.



**Temperature:** Peak summers see a high of 48°C while in winters the temperature dips to 2 - 3°C.
